I. Prerequisites

The concerned public are the healthy adults over 18 years old who wants :

- ✓ Learn about a living language ;
- ✓ Update their knowledge or deepen them ;
- ✓ Enrich their knowledges.



II. Levels and training programs

The certificate of competence in Mandarin Chinese is a certificate of private institute of higher education materializing an academic semester of training in Mandarin Chinese and the acquired linguistic capacity in Mandarin Chinese by a student.

CESL in Chinese Mandarin are obtained in 1 academic semester training per level and (30 ECTS). Each semester training is independent. There are 6 levels : elementary A, elementary B, intermediate C, intermediate D, advanced E and advanced F.

At the beginning of the courses the level of the participants is evaluated to establish their ability and to check that they take part in the level which corresponds to them. There are written and oral tests.

Audience

Students who have no prior experience in learning Chinese or know ± 300 Chinese expressions, have learned pinyin and mastered a small vocabulary but cannot express in fluent and complete sentences.

Training program focus on teaching basic Chinese phonetic, vocabulary, sentence structures and grammar using everyday topics. Phonetics, tone exercises and drills ensure that participants quickly attain correct pronunciation and intonation.

Moreover, students learn the Chinese radical system, and the adequate writing of the basic characters

Objectives

Students will master 600 Chinese characters and 160 grammar points.

Students will be able to carry on basic conversation in Chinese. Students should be able to solve common problems encountered in daily life using the language knowledges and skills acquired in class.

Audience

Students who know more than 600 Chinese expressions, basic Chinese grammar rules, commonly used sentence patterns and express in simple phrases on daily topics. Phonetics, tone exercises and drills ensure that participants quickly attain correct pronunciation and intonation. Students begin to write simple texts in Chinese.

Objectives

Students will master 1200 Chinese characters and 300 grammar points.

Students will be able to carry on basic conversation in Chinese. Students should be able to solve common problems encountered in daily life using the language knowledges and skills acquired in class. Students will have the adequate language proficiency to survive

in a Chinese-speaking world.

Audience

Students who know more than 1200 Chinese expressions, and understand elementary Chinese grammar. Students are able to conduct conversations about common topics in relatively well organized paragraphs.

Classes build on basic knowledge of Chinese, will increase the level of grammar and vocabulary, which enables students to express functionally in different contexts.

Objectives

Students will master 1800 Chinese characters and 460 grammar points. Students will be able to carry on basic conversation in fluent Chinese using more complicated sentence structures. They will have the language proficiency to take the undergraduate courses on various subjects in Chinese universities and reach HSK Level 4-5.

Audience

Students who know \pm 1800 Chinese expressions, elementary grammar and a sample of standard sentences.

At the end of the program, listening, conversation, reading, drafting and translation exercises will have learned students to express themselves perfectly in Chinese in various contexts.

Objectives

Students will master 2500 Chinese characters and 650 grammar points, and will have learned how to express themselves usually in Chinese in various contexts and reach level 5-6 of the HSK.

III. Mandarin Chinese semester training Educational organization

- Training program include all aspects of language :
 - ✓ Speaking and phonetics.
 - ✓ Listening.
 - ✓ Reading and understanding.

- ✓ Writing, bushou learning.
 - ✓ Grammar, vocabulary, exercises.
- Each class week :
- ✓ 16 - 20 hours Chinese language courses Monday to Friday from 08:00 to 17:00.
 - ✓ 18 hours training means 18-25 hours weekly homework beside classes.
 - ✓ Class growth 12-15 students.
- Number of credits granted for the training : 30 ECTS (1 academic semester).
- Age of the students : from 18 to 35 years.
- Each student has to provide a valid health and repatriation insurance certificate covering the duration of the stay.

3 months internship

You provide us your CV in English with a passport photo, and a motivation in English indicating the branch of industry wished for your internship.

Students are placed in a company corresponding to the desired branch of industry. They can be placed in one or more companies during the internship. Internship is generally not paid because it is part of a training but sometimes if the student gives satisfaction to the company a gratification can be granted.

Placements are determined by your English and Chinese level, the degrees of the candidate (if any), the availability of the offers, and the preference of the student.

On request of the company, the student abilities for the work will be evaluated. At the end of the internship the students will receive a letter of reference of the company.

We draw your attention to the fact that in China an “internship” in company for a foreigner who would be remunerated is regarded in China as a work and requires a visa of work.



IV. Administrative organization

Choice of training level

Supply the copy of the certificate giving evidence of your level of Chinese for applying in CESLCH-B, CESLCH-C, CESLCH-D levels modules.

The true knowledge of the writing of 600 basic Chinese characters and elementary grammar is a compulsory prerequisite for the CESLCH-B level (if you know only the writing of the pinyin, the phonetic pronunciation, you have to choose a registration in CESLCH-A level).

Registration

Inscriptions for semester training are closed two months before the starting date of the training (end of December for the Spring session).

No later registration will be accepted (date as postmark for the file sent by post).

Your registration file :

1. The entirely informed registration form.
2. A copy of your passport (valid six months after training's end).
3. A copy of your last degree and 4 colour photos (4,5 cm x 3,5 cm).
4. A copy of your health & repatriation insurance covering the duration of your stay.
5. A copy of the receipt showing that you have sent the application fee.
6. A CV and motivation letter in English.

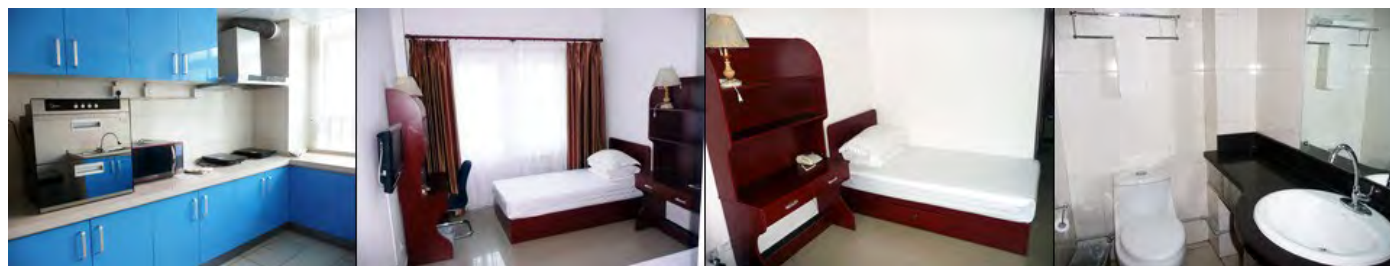
Other costs :

VII. University campus accommodation

You will choose your arrival date in the week before your training and you must leave the campus before the end of the next week following the end your training.

The students have access to a kitchen to prepare their meal if needed.

VIII. University canteens

The daily spending to take three meals (breakfast, lunch and diner) in the university canteens of the campus is about 40 RMB (that is ±5 €).

The average price of a meal in a fast food (KFC, Mac-Donald) is about 25 RMB.

It is necessary you plan to spend 5 RMB/day to buy some mineral water (in China the tap water is not drinkable). Campus has a supermarket opened from 07:00 to 22:00.



IX. Registration modalities

You must be over 18 years and less than 60 years old before training's beginning.

1. Send the complete registration form with the copy of the training's payment and the accommodation's booking if you wish to live on the university campus.

2. You will receive a registration confirmation one week after we received bank statement of application fee's payment.

3. Two months before the beginning of the training, we take delivery of the JW202 form authorizing you to study in China delivered by Xi'an's public Security Office and you will ask for a student visa in a Chinese consulate.

4. You pay your training.

5. One month before your training you will receive your invitation letter and JW202 form to apply for a student visa in a Chinese consulate. When applying for your visa, please remember to bring along with you your valid passport (validity at least 6 months after the training's end), the original copy of the university's admission notification, accommodation's booking, your health insurance certificate for your stay in China and one 4,5cm x 3,5cm photo.

6. You will pay in cash in RMB your accommodation if you booked an accommodation on campus upon your arrival on the university campus
