## II. Levels and training programs

# SUMMER CAMPUS INSTITUT PEÑA



At the beginning of the training the level of each student is evaluated.

After completing the course you will receive a certificate “Certificate of Short-term Chinese Study” for the whole course if you have attended at least 90% of the classes. This will record : the course you have taken, duration, objectives and level of Chinese and number of hours. If you have attended less than 90% of your classes, the certificate will only record the actual number of classes (hours) you attended.

## Beginner elementary level CEFRL A1 (4 weeks 60 hours training)

This Chinese course for beginners has for objective in 360 Chinese characters :

- to be able to recognise familiar words and very basic phrases concerning myself, my family and immediate concrete surroundings when people speak slowly and clearly ;
- to be able to understand familiar names, words and very simple sentences, for example on notices and posters or in catalogues ;
- to be able to interact in a simple way provided the other person is prepared to repeat or rephrase things at a slower rate of speech and help me formulate what I'm trying to say. I can ask and answer simple questions in areas of immediate need or on very familiar topics ;
- be able to use simple phrases and sentences to describe where I live and people I know.

## Elementary level 2 CEFRL A2 (4 weeks 60 hours training)

This elementary Chinese course addresses students mastering approximately 350-400 Chinese characters and being able to express themselves by simple sentences and has for objective besides the landing of 760 Chinese characters :

- be able to understand phrases and the highest frequency vocabulary related to areas of most immediate personal relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local area, employment) ;

- be able to catch the main point in short, clear, simple messages and announcements ;
- be able to read very short, simple texts ;
- be able to communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar topics and activities, handle very short social exchanges, even though I can not usually understand enough to keep the conversation going myself ;
- be able to use a series of phrases and sentences to describe in simple terms my family and other people, living conditions, my educational background and my present or most recent job.

### **Pre-intermediate level CEFRL B1 (4 weeks 80 hours training)**

This intermediate Chinese course addresses students mastering the phonetic bases and approximately 800 Chinese characters, being able to express themselves by simple sentences and answer frequently asked questions of the everyday life, and has for objective besides the landing of 1200 Chinese characters :

- be able to understand the main points of clear standard speech on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc, and understand the main point of many radio or TV programmes on current affairs or topics of personal or professional interest when the delivery is relatively slow and clear ;
- be able to understand texts that consist mainly of high frequency everyday or job-related language and understand the description of events, feelings and wishes in personal letters ;
- be able to deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken and enter unprepared into conversation on topics that are familiar, of personal interest or pertinent to everyday life (e.g. family, hobbies, work, travel and current events) ;
- be able to connect phrases in a simple way in order to describe experiences and events, my dreams, hopes and ambitions, briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans, and narrate a story or relate the plot of a book or film and describe my reactions.

### **Intermediate level CEFRL B2 (4 weeks 80 hours training)**

This intermediate Chinese course addresses students mastering approximately 1200 Chinese characters, the elementary grammar and a sample of typical sentences, and has for objective besides the landing of 1600 Chinese characters :

- be able to understand extended speech and lectures and follow even complex lines of argument provided the topic is reasonably familiar and understand most TV news and current affairs programmes ;
- be able to read articles and reports concerned with contemporary problems in which the writers adopt particular attitudes or viewpoints and understand contemporary literary prose ;
- be able to interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible and take an active part in discussion in familiar contexts, accounting for and sustaining my view ;
- be able to present clear, detailed descriptions on a wide range of subjects related to my field of interest and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

### **III. Educational organization of the « summer Campus » trainings**

- Training program include all aspects of language:
  - ✓ Speaking and phonetics.
  - ✓ Listening.
  - ✓ Reading and understanding.



- ✓ Writing, bushu learning.
  - ✓ Grammar, vocabulary, exercises.
- Each week training :
- ✓ 15 or 20 hours Chinese language courses Monday to Friday from 08:00 to 12:00.
  - ✓ 20 hours training means 10 hours weekly homework beside classes.
  - ✓ Class growth 8-12 students.
- Number of credits granted for the training : 3-4 ECTS.
- Age of the students : from 18 to 55 years old.
- Each student has to provide a valid health and repatriation insurance certificate covering the duration of the stay.



#### **IV. Administrative organization**

##### Procedure of choice of training level

Supply the copy of the certificate giving evidence of your level of Chinese for applying in CECR A2, CECR B1, CECR B2 levels modules.

The true knowledge of the writing of 350 basic Chinese characters is a compulsory prerequisite for the CECR A2 level (if you know only the writing of the pinyin, the phonetic pronunciation, you have to choose a registration in CECR A1 level).

##### Registration Procedure

**Registrations for the July Summer Campus trainings will be closed on April 30th, 2012.**  
**Registrations for the August Summer Campus trainings will be closed on May 30th, 2012.**

No later registration will be accepted.

1. The entirely informed registration form.
2. A copy of your passport.
3. A copy of the receipt showing that you have sent the application fee.
4. A copy of your health & repatriation insurance covering the duration of your stay.

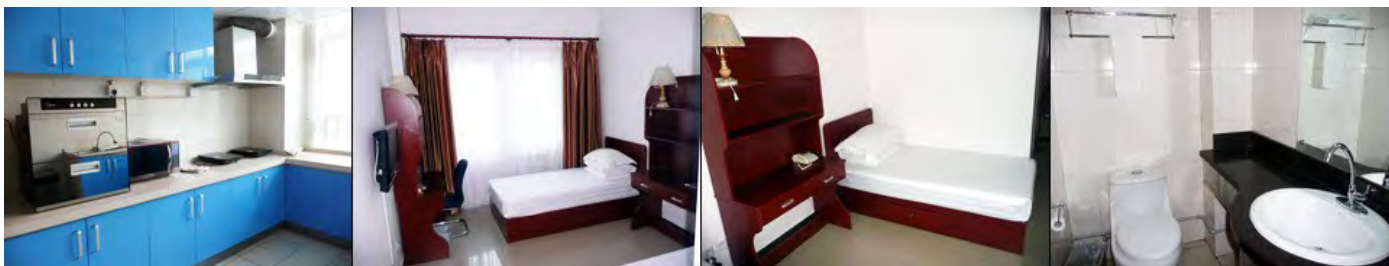

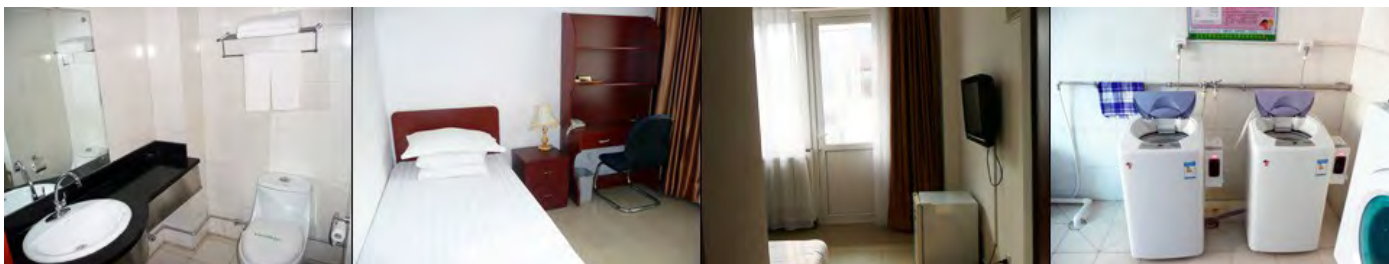

## VI. University campus accommodation

You will choose your arrival date in the week before your training and you must leave the campus before the end of the next day following the end your training.

The students have access to a kitchen to prepare their meal if needed.

Beijing Capital airport pick-up : 500 RMB (60 €).

## VII. University Canteens

The daily spending to take three meals (breakfast, lunch and diner) in the university canteens of the campus is about 40 RMB (that is ±5 €).

The average price of a meal in a fast food (KFC, Mac-Donald) is about 25 RMB.

It is necessary you plan to spend 5 RMB/day to buy some mineral water (in China the tap water is not drinkable).

The campus has a small supermarket opened from 07:00 to 22:00.



## VIII. Registration modalities

You must be over 18 years old before the beginning of the training.

If you are over 60 years old you have to supply a medical certificate authorizing you to study in China and indicating that you have no health problem.

1. Send the complete registration form with the copy of the training's application fee payment.
2. You will receive a registration confirmation one week after we received bank statement of application fee's payment.
3. At the latest two months before the beginning of the training, as soon as the public Security Office of Beijing gives it to us, we take delivery of the JW202 form authorizing you to study in China and ask for a student visa in a Chinese consulate.
4. You will pay your training (and accommodation) and receive your JW202.
5. One month before your training you will receive your invitation letter and JW202 form to apply for a student visa in a Chinese consulate. When applying for your visa, please remember to bring along with you your valid passport (validity at least 6 months after the training's end), the original copy of the university's admission notification, accommodation's booking, your health insurance certificate for your stay in China and one 4,5cm x 3,5cm photo.
6. One week before your arrival you let us know your flight details to estimate your arrival time on campus.

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
